Arzu Alpan cites growing medical physics field. And young students are migrating to medical physics. Takes at least three years and a successful topical meeting to start a Division. The name "Computational" Medical Physics needs computational in the name otherwise its just applications. Had over 100 papers of 380 on medical computational physics. There's no risk in trying.
